


### GENERAL INFO

If you have never been to Poland, you should know that:

- Poland has a moderate climate.
   There are 4 seasons.
- The currency in Poland is Zloty (1PLN = 0,22 EUR; 0,21 GBP; 0,25 USD). ATM machines can be found almost everywhere. Card payments are accepted in most shops, restaurants, bars etc.
- chocolates called 'Ptasie Mleczko' are a delicacy. Typical Polish dishes are: pierogi (dumplings), bigos (hunter's stew) and schabowy (pork chop).





# HOW TO TRAVEL?

There is an airport in Poznan (POZ) that serves many domestic and international destinations. The airport also serves flights of low-cost carriers such as Ryanair, Wizzair. As Poznan is situated on the route Berlin - Warsaw, you can also fly to one of these cities and then get train to Poznań.

The cost of a train ticket is 12 - 44€.

### IN THE CITY


You can get from the airport to the center of Poznan by bus line 159 and Uber or cab. To get to the Institute of Human Genetics PAS take line 168. You can buy a ticket in ticket machines, bookstore or using applications such as jakdojade.pl. If you want to stay longer in Poznan, make yourself a PEKA card (season ticket).


# DISCOVER POZNAŃ









City Hall and goats (goats' butting display takes place every day at 12:00 on the tower

Scientists of our institute conduct research within projects obtained in competitive calls for proposals and publish in reputable journals.


The Journal of Applied Genetics published by Springer Nature is coedited at our institute (IF:3.24).
